Audition Sides - Franz, Maria, Frau Schmidt

ALL

(shouted)

DO!

The CHILDREN and MARIA laugh. FRANZ enters.

Begin

FRANZ

Come children, it's time for your exercise.

The CHILDREN ad lib their protestations – "Do we have to?"... "Not now..." "Can't we go later?" – etc. as FRAU SCHMIDT enters on the balcony, carrying curtains, and comes down the stairs.

Come along now, come along...

FRANZ ushers the CHILDREN off. FRAU SCHMIDT enters carrying a pile of curtains as MARIA returns the guitar to its case.

FRAU SCHMIDT

Your room is ready, Fräulein Maria. I hope you find it satisfactory.

MARIA

It's already the most beautiful room I've ever had! What are those?

FRAU SCHMIDT

The old curtains from your room.

MARIA

It looks like they have plenty of wear left in them.

FRAU SCHMIDT

The new ones have been hung.

MARIA

When the children return from their exercise, I think I'll have them change into their play clothes and take them—

FRAU SCHMIDT

They have no such clothes. The von Trapp children do not play – they march.

(referring to the guitar)

And you can put that away. You won't be using it.

MARIA

Why not?

FRAU SCHMIDT

The Captain won't have music here.

MARIA

He won't have music?
